Re: Experience with Josh & Robertson Floors

I can confirm I worked with Robertson Floors on the Salvatore Ferragamo store in downtown Vancouver. Overall the project was a huge success both in timeline and quality. This particular project had a very tight timeline, which is a challenge when working with multiple trades that overlap. The first portion of their scope of work was installing a random pattern floor with large natural piece of stone to the floor. They used a drypack method to set the mortar bed and there was an extremely tight tolerance so the leveling was key. Robertson's scope of work was to install a very high end natural stone, shipped directly from Italy under a tight timeline to the façade of the store. The natural stone had to be stored, pre-cut and installed using clips and structural element components. The communication from Josh was effective and clear, their crews worked long hours to ensure we hit our required date and the finished product is exceptional. There was constant inspection of the work and the price was very fair.

I would recommend using Josh from Robertson floors in the future.
